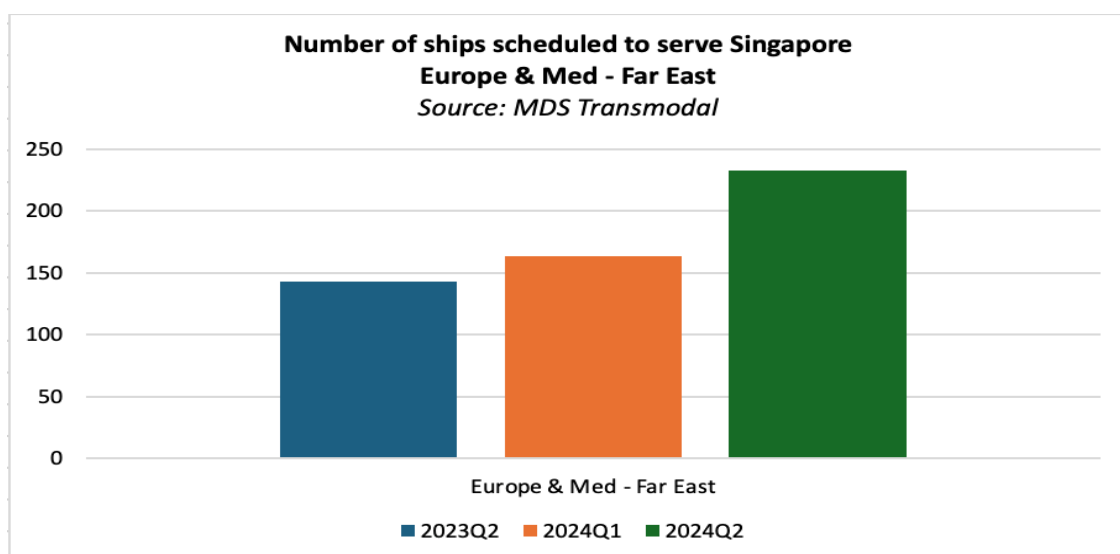

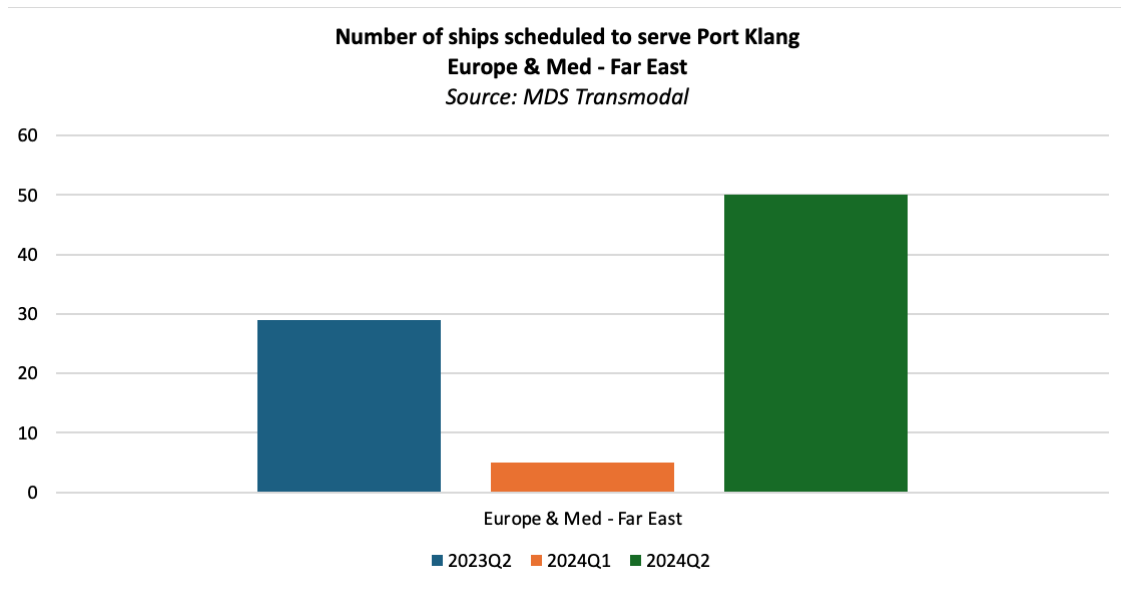

Red Sea rerouting causing Asian port congestion

- Diversions of container ships via the Cape of Good Hope has resulted in a continuous reconfiguration of port calls and vessel sizes on services as carriers adjust Asia to Europe loops to cope with the latest demands. Some ports are reported to be very congested.
